- **Isa.60:16;** "and thou shall know that I the **LORD** [am] thy **Saviour** and thy **Redeemer**, the <u>mighty One of Jacob</u>."
- Ps. 78:35; "And they remembered that God [was] their rock, and the high God their Redeemer."
- Isa.63:16; ".. Thou O LORD, [art] our father, our Redeemer; thy name [is] from everlasting."
- **Isa. 48:16,17;** "Come ye near unto **me**, hear ye this; I have not spoken in secret <u>from the beginning</u>; from the time that it was, there [am] I: and now the <u>Lord GOD</u>, and his <u>Spirit</u>, hath sent me. Thus saith the <u>LORD</u>, thy **Redeemer**, the <u>Holy One</u> of Israel; I [am] the <u>LORD thy God</u> which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way [that] thou shouldest go."
- **Jer. 50:34**; "Their <u>Redeemer</u>, [is] strong; the <u>LORD of hosts</u> [is] <u>his name</u>: he shall thoroughly plead their cause..."
- Isa. 47:4; "[As for] our Redeemer, the LORD of hosts [is] his name, the Holy One of Israel."
- Job 19:25,26; "... I know [that] my <u>Redeemer liveth</u>, and [that] <u>he shall stand at the latter [day] upon the earth</u>: And [though] after my skin [worms] destroy this [body], <u>yet in my flesh shall I see God.</u>"
- **Ps. 49:6,7;** "They that trust in their wealth, and boast themselves in the multitude of their riches; None [of them] can by any means <u>redeem</u> his brother, nor give to <u>God</u> a ransom for him:"
- **Gal. 3:13 (Phillips);** "Now <u>Christ</u> has **Redeemed** us from the curse of the law's <u>condemnation</u>, by <u>Himself</u> becoming a curse for us when He was crucified..."
- Col. 1:14; "In whom we have redemption through His blood, [even] the forgiveness of sins:"
- I Pet. 1: 18-20; "Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, [as] silver and gold... But with the <u>precious blood of Christ</u>, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world..."

Hebrews 9:12; "Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by <u>His own blood</u> he entered in <u>once</u> into the holy place, having obtained <u>eternal redemption</u> [for us]."
