

Jesus Accepted Worship

Matt.8:2, 3; “And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. And Jesus put forth [his] hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.”

Matt. 9:18, 25; “... behold, there came a certain ruler, and worshipped him, saying, My daughter is even now dead: but come and lay thy hand upon her, and she shall live... He went in, and took her by the hand, and the maid arose.”

Matt. 14:24-33; “But the ship was now in the midst of the sea, tossed with waves... Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea... the disciples... cried out for fear... Jesus spake.. unto them, ... it is I; be not afraid.... Peter said, Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water... And Peter walked on the water. But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried... Lord save me.. Jesus stretched forth [his] hand, and caught him, and said.. O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt? And when they were come into the ship, the wind ceased. Then they that were in the ship came and worshipped him, saying, Of a truth thou art the Son of God.”

Matt.15:25, 28; “Then came she and worshipped him, saying, Lord, help me... O woman, great [is] thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour.”

Matt. 17:14, 15, 18; “.. there came to him a [certain] man, kneeling down to him, and saying, Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is a lunatic, and sore vexed: for oftentimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water... And Jesus rebuked the devil; and he departed out of him: and the child was cured from that very hour.”

Matt.20:20; “Then came to him the mother of Zebedee's children with her sons, worshipping [him], and desiring a certain thing of him.”

Matt.28:9; “And as they {Mary Magdalene and the other Mary} went to tell his disciples, behold, Jesus met them, saying, All hail. And they came and held him by the feet, and worshipped him.”

Matt. 28:16, 17; “Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, into a mountain where Jesus had appointed them. And when they saw him, they worshipped him.”

Mark 1:40; “And there came a leper to him, beseeching him, and kneeling down to him, and saying unto him, If thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.”

Mark 5:2-15; “there met him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit... when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped him, and cried.. What have I to do with thee, Jesus, [thou] Son of the most high God? I adjure thee by God, that thou torment me not. For he said unto him, Come out of the man, [thou] unclean spirit... the unclean spirits went out, and entered into the swine: And they ... see him that was possessed with the devil, sitting... clothed, and in his right mind...”

Mark 10:17; “And when he was gone forth into the way, there came one running, and kneeled to him, and asked him, Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?”

Luke 5:8; “... Simon Peter ... fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, Depart from me; for I am a sinful man, **O Lord.**”

Luke 24:50-52; “And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his hands, and blessed them... he was parted from them, and carried up into heaven. And they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy:”

John 9:1-38; “... as [Jesus] passed by, he saw a man which was blind from [his] birth... He anointed the eyes of the blind man... Go wash them in the pool of Siloam.. He went.. and washed, and came seeing... the Pharisees .. cast him out .. Jesus heard.. and when he had found him... said.. Dost thou believe on the Son of God? ... Thou hast seen Him, and it is He that talketh with thee. And he said, **Lord, I believe.** And he worshipped Him.”

Isa. 45:22,23; “Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I [am] **God**, and [there is] **none else**. I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth [in] righteousness, and shall not return, That unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear.”

Romans 14:10, 11; “ .. for we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ. For it is written, [As] I live, saith the **Lord**, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.”

Phil. 2:9, 10; “Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, ... “

Rev. 14:6,7; “And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven... Saying with a loud voice, **Fear God**, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and **worship** him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.”

Rev. 5:12-14; “Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing. And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, [be] unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever. And the four beasts said, Amen. And the four [and] twenty elders fell down and worshipped him that liveth for ever and ever.”

Ps. 95:6; “O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker.”
