

I AND MY FATHER ARE ONE

1. To Hate Jesus is to Hate God

John 15:23; “He that hateth me hateth my Father also.”

2. To Despise Jesus is to Despise God

Luke 10:16; “.. he that **despiseth you despiseth me**; and he that **despiseth me despiseth him** that sent me.”

3. To Deny Jesus is to Deny God

John 22, 23; “...He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son. Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: [(but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also].”

4. To See Jesus is to See God.

John 12:45; “And he that seeth me seeth him that sent me.”

John 14:8, 9; “Philip saith unto him, Lord, show us the Father... Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? He that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou [then], Show us the Father?”

5. To Know Jesus is to Know God

John 8:19; “.. Jesus answered, Ye neither know me, nor my Father: if ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also.”

John 14:7; “If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.”

6. To Believe in Jesus is to Believe in God

John 12:44; “Jesus cried and said, He that believeth on me, believeth not on me, but on him that sent me.

John 14:1; “Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.”

7. To Receive Jesus is to Receive God

Mark 9:37; “Whosoever shall receive one of such children in my name, receiveth me: and whosoever shall receive me, receiveth not me, but him that sent me.”

Luke 9:48; “...whosoever shall receive this child in my name receiveth me: and whosoever shall receive me receiveth him that sent me..” See also **Matt. 10:40**

8.To Honor Jesus is to Honor God

John 5:23; “That all [men] should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him.”

9. Who Sends The Holy Spirit?

John 14:16; “And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;”

John 15:26; “But when the Comforter is come, **whom I will send unto you** {from} the Father, [even] the **Spirit of truth**, which proceedeth **from the Father**, he shall testify of me:”

John 16:7; “...for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, **I will send him unto you.**”

10. CHRIST RAISED FROM THE DEAD

John 2:19-21; “Jesus answered and said unto them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up. Then said the Jews, Forty and six years was this temple in building, and wilt thou rear it up in three days? But **he spake of the temple of his body.**”

John 5:21, 26; “For as the Father **raiseth up the dead**, and **quickeneth** [them]; even so the **Son quickeneth** whom he will... For as the Father hath **life in himself**; so hath he given to **the Son to have life in himself**;”

Romans 10:9; “That if thou shalt **confess** with thy mouth the **Lord Jesus**, and shalt **believe** in thine heart that **God** hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.”

Romans 6:4; “...Christ was raised up from the dead **by the glory of the Father**, ..”

John 10:17, 18; “Therefore doth **my Father love me**, because **I lay down my life**, that I might take it again. **No man taketh it from me**, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again...”

Acts 2:24; “Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that he should be holden of it.”

John 10:30; “I and [my] Father are one.”

Isa. 9:6; “For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.”

John 5:43; “I am come in my Father's name,...”

John 8:42; “Jesus said unto them, If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, ... sent me.”

Exodus 20:1, 6; “... God spake... And showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.”

Deut. 5:10; “...showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me and keep my commandments.”

John 14:9,15; “Jesus saith...If you love me, keep my commandments.”

Matt.22:36-38; “Master, which [is] the great commandment in the law? Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.”

John 14:21,23; “He that hath {my} commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him... If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.”

11. Equality

John 5:17, 18; “..Jesus answered..my father worketh... and I work. Therefore the Jews sought.. to kill Him, because he.. said... that God was His father, making Himself equal with God.”

Phil. 2:6; “Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:”

John 6:46; “Not that any man hath seen the Father, save he which is {of} God, he hath seen the Father.”

John 1-3, 14; “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God... All things were made by him... And the Word was made flesh...”

John 5:22; “For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:”

Rom. 2:16; “In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ...”

Romans 1:7, I Thess. 1:1, Eph. 1: 2.

“...Grace to you and peace from God our father, {and} the Lord Jesus Christ.”

Gal. 1:1; “Paul, an apostle... by Jesus Christ, {and} God the Father...”

John 17:3; “And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.”

Matt.28:19; “Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:”

“...God our Saviour...”

“... Jesus Christ... our Saviour.”

Titus 2:13; “Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God {and} our Saviour Jesus Christ;”

John 17:5; “And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.”

John 17:1; “... glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify Thee:”

John 13:31, 32: “Jesus said, Now is the Son of man glorified, and God is glorified in him. If God be glorified in him, God shall also glorify him in himself, and shall straightway glorify him.”

Luke 9:26; “...he shall come in his own glory, and [in his] Father's, and of the holy angels.”

Rev. 21:23; “And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, {and} the Lamb [is] the light thereof.”

John 16:15; “All things that the Father hath are mine...”

John 17:10; “And all mine are thine, and thine are mine...”

Luke 10:22; “All things are delivered to me of my Father: and no man knoweth who the Son is, but the Father; and who the Father is, but the Son, and [he] to whom the Son will reveal [him].”

John 14:6; "...no man cometh unto the Father, but by me."

John 14:11; "Believe me that I [am] in the Father, and the Father in me..."

John 10:38; "...that ye may know, and **believe**, that the **Father [is] in me**, and **I in him.**"

John 8:16; "...for I am not alone, but I and the Father that sent me."

II John 9; "Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the **doctrine of Christ**, **he hath {both} the Father** and **the Son.**"

The "Gospel" is called "**Gospel of God**" 7 times.
